1. Apologies were noted for Cllr Thompson
2. There were no declarations of interest on items on the agenda
3. There were no dispensation requests
4. The minutes of 22 January 2019 were noted
5. **To make recommendation re mural of the Town Hall**
Recommendation
The ownership of the mural is conformed as it was commissioned by the Coleford Area Partnership (CAP) & their opinion sought
To be reviewed on the CAP response
6. **To make recommendation re the phone box project**
The clerk to ascertain the cost of moving a telephone box
Recommendation
The Community is asked what they would like done with the phone boxes
7. **To make recommendation re the open green spaces at Angel Vale**
Recommendation
To have the quoted works for the trees completed
To create a LEMP plan for the site
Appoint the contractor used by FoDDC to complete the works for 2019 -20
8. **To make recommendation re dog waste bins in the Broadwell/ Coalway area**
It was noted that there appeared to be a scarcity of bins in this area. Well below the number of bins in other areas
Recommendation
Ask the FoDDC to provide bins for this area
9. **To make recommendation re the Parish Flower contract**
The comparison to the other market towns was not good
Recommendation
To review the wording of the contract and to arrange a meeting with the contractor
Obtain costing for planted planters
10. **To make recommendation re the next stage of the Stepbridge consultation**
Recommendation
A pop up event is held on the site with some low key entertainment
This is held during the Easter holidays possibly weekend 14 April 19
A flyer is distributed prior to the event to all houses
Similar consultation to Bells with graffiti board, etc.
