Cllr Penny summarised, and the Town Clerk's update was noted re: defibrillators, and the schedule of work re: other kiosks in the spring.

7. To make recommendation re latest BT Phone box consultation

Cllr. Penny summarised and, after further discussion:

Recommendation:

That the kiosk on Lords Hill is not decommissioned, as it is now the only one still 'live' in Coleford town centre.

8. To make recommendation re street lights in Mushet Walk with solar panels. Recommendation:

That, subject to pricing, solar lights are purchased, and permission is sought from the landlord, for installation.

That the existing Victorian lights remain.

9. To make recommendation to progress Stepbridge replacement play equipment Recommendation:
