## 7. To have an update on the proposed children's, & young person & outlying settlement during August (Clirs Drury & Ball)

Cllr Lusty reported that there would be workshops for young adults at the Angus Buchanan VC Memorial Ground on cycle maintenance during the summer and at the Family Fund Day on 12 August. She had applied for funding from the Crime Safety Partnership.(CSP)

Cllr Ball had approached MSA Academy (mixed martial arts)

#### Recommendation

That the Council are kept informed of the grant to the CSP re the cycle workshops and a view is taken by the Council should the application fall short of the required sum.

Cllr Ball to obtain costings for 4 separate workshops staged by MSA Academy in different locations in the parish. (1 each week on a day to suit during August.) If the proposal has been received by 17 July 2017 then it can be considered at Full Council on July 25 2017.

That costings are obtained to provide young people art workshops at the end of August with an added attraction of "Diddy Cars" supplied by Best Parties. Cllr Ball to liaise with Cllr Drury & Tom Cousins about this provision.
