- 1. Apologies were noted from Cllrs Ball & Kay
- 2. There were no declarations of interest on items on the agenda
- 3. There were no dispensations requests
- 4. The minutes of 3 July 2018 were noted It was reported that the cycle club had chosen not to proceed with the Bike Fest so this event has been cancelled

5. To make recommendation re budget allocation for 18 -19 Recommendation

After some analysis is was recommended that £12,000.00 is taken from the events budget for the Bells project £2000.00 is taken from the marketing budget for the Bells project The twinning budget to remain untouched

6. To make recommendation actions for the Sealed Knot Parade in February 2019 Recommendation

That the event occurs on Saturday 23 February 2019 at 11.30am.

7. To have an update form WW1 working group and agree the recommendations.

Cllr Holloway reported that preparations were progressing well. It was requested that some parachute silk is purchased to provide the backing for the poppies. The committee is approaching a parachute producer to see if any off cuts are available or even a donation of silk is possible, if not it was agreed that costings should be obtained with a view to purchase.

8. To recommend a date for the Civic Dinner 2019 Recommendation

That the event is held on Saturday 6 April 2019. The venue is yet to be determined

9. To determine the panel for the Pride of Coleford Community Award Recommendation

That an independent panel is created with 5 representatives to include 1 from the Town Council, 1 from Foresters Forest, 1 from LRS Suntory, 1 from the local shops (Vicki Morgan) 1 from SPP Pumps.

The Clerk to arrange

The panel will match the nominees against the criteria and those that reach the standard will be awarded the honour

10.To make recommendation re the date & format of the awards ceremony Recommendation

That the Council hold an event with all nominees and nominators plus the great and the good from the parish where a tasteful glass trophy will be presented. The date of the ceremony is yet to be determined.
